Protest Hospital Industry Attack on RN Rights

Pending Labor Board Decision Will Imperil Protections, Standards, Patient Advocacy Role

At the request of the American Hospital Association (AHA), the national union of hospital corporations, the National Labor Relations Board (NLRB), will soon issue a major ruling that could jeopardize the ability of RNs to receive the protections of union representation and the ability to act as patient advocates.

The hospital industry wants the NLRB to reclassify all RNs as "supervisors". You and your colleagues could lose the ability to join with co-workers to bargain collectively for a stronger RN voice in your facility.
