Her current research focuses on Chinese labor issues. She has published widely on Chinese workers' conditions, trade unions, and labor rights issues. She is committed to campaigning for labor rights to be recognized as human rights. She is author of *China's Workers' Under Assault*, and other publications dealing with Chinese labor rights, trade unions, the WTO and labor, social clauses, and related issues. Chan has done extensive work with the Chinese Working Women's Network and has just returned from a worker's training project inside supplier factories in Shenzhen, China.

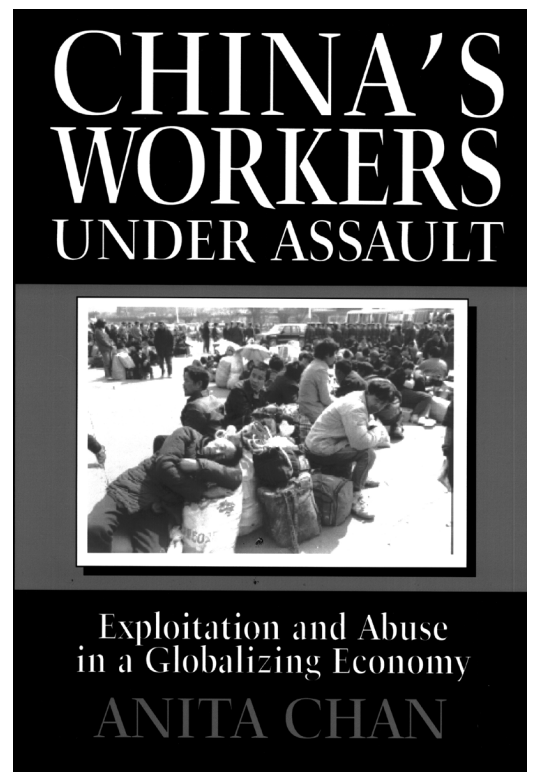
