

Appeal Launched

Help the communities destroyed by the tsunamis

Sewalanka Foundation is launching an appeal for the people affected by the tsunami in Sri Lanka. The multiple tsunamis that hit the Sri Lankan coast line on 26 December 2004 have destroyed hundreds of villages, killed over 4,500 people and displaced over one million people. This is the worst natural disaster that the people of Sri Lanka have ever faced.



Sewalanka Foundation has offices in all the coastal districts affected by the tsunami and is receiving urgent requests from survivors. Those that have survived are now in urgent need of basic supplies like cooked food, drinking water, dry rations and cooking utensils. In order to purchase these facilitate we have established a separate bank account where money can be directly donated by those concerned and wishing to help. The details are:
